



Bonnie's Letter

Philippians 4:4-7 "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, Rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

Dear Friends.

I have many favorites in scripture. This passage from Philippians is one I turn to when I am afraid, anxious, or upset. When I am at my wit's end, I try to remember these words from Paul's letter to the church in Philippi. I try not to worry. I try to put everything in the hands of God. I pray and try to let go and let God. That is not easy for a recovering control freak like me. I like to claim order in my life — at least order as I see and feel it. It is tough for me to let go. It is easy to offer thanks and gratitude. I love to list the things I have to be grateful for as I pray each day. My prayers of gratitude have become a wonderful way to end my evening prayer time. My mind rests more easily when my heart rests in gratitude. Does that work for you?

There are days when each conversation seems difficult, each situation seems without solution, each statement I make is met with disagreement and argument. Yet, I am grateful when people share their ideas and opinions, even if they are the direct opposite of my own. There's trust in the sharing, in the naming of different opinions and in the real striving to understand one another. I may not like the varied opinions or criticism, but I love that people are strong enough to share their ideas with me. On the other hand, I disregard anonymous complaints or the idea that individuals speak about "we" or "some people" rather than just for themselves. We live in a time when people have forgotten how to have a dialogue, a give and take of opinion, information, and belief. We seem to like "diatribes" which includes just repeating the same message louder and louder without any attempt to listen. If I seem to have wandered far afield of my opening paragraph, I have. One of the things I cannot control and need to put in the hands of God is my tendency to worry about criticism and disagreements. Criticism is hard to accept with grace and harder to offer thanks for. Yet, when I can accept different ideas, listen with an open heart, and offer thanks to God for the myriad voices in my midst, then I have truly opened my heart to those who love, believe, feel, and engage the world differently. There is grace in that acceptance and that is truly what our UCC covenantal relationships are about - respectfully listening and striving to understand one another. For that I can truly give thanks.
