
- The Bingo was on October 2nd. Thank you to everyone that came out to help!



Bonnie's Letter

Friends.

I write a lot about covenant in these letters to you. The expectation of our congregations and authorized ministers is that we, as conference volunteers and staff, will be in covenant with them. I think it is important to recognize that covenant is about mutuality in our expectations and relationships. Jesus prayed in John 17 "that they may all be one" and the United Church of Christ has taken that to be our motto and foundational scripture. What does it mean to be one? How are we one? Why are we one? What behaviors demonstrate we are one?

As I meet with congregations and ministers, I remind us that the United Church of Christ is a "big tent" where differences of opinions, theological interpretations, social justice perspectives, and beliefs are welcome. I believe that with my whole heart. And I believe that we each and all have a responsibility to act in partnership within that "big tent." To me that means the conference provides mission support, programming and education support, and leadership. It also means that my role as conference minister is to care about each and every one of our congregations and our ministers. It means, too, that our congregations and ministers have their own responsibilities to move into and maintain relationships with one another, and with the conference staff and volunteers.

Yesterday we held our Ministry Day event with participation from 47 of our 200+ ministers. The topic was relevant to us all: hybrid ministry. Those in attendance affirmed the importance and effectiveness of the educational experience. The program was wonderful. Worship was meaningful. Attendance was disappointing, given that pre-COVID pandemic attendance was twice what it was yesterday. Our current registrations for the upcoming WISE for Mental Health Conference is similarly small. Our current registration for the Fall Conference Meeting isn't even at 30 yet and we need at least 100 voting members to have a quorum. Attendance for the meeting has routinely been about 150. There are 3 registrations for our December 3 Lay Worship Leadership Training, something asked for by several congregations without ministerial leadership.

Why am I talking about this now, in October? Well, I am disappointed.

Our teams and committees are working hard to meet the needs of congregations and ministers and we diligently offer programs of education based on important topics and areas of interest. We strive to assure that educational opportunities address the continuing education policies the Committee on Ministry has established. Where is the partnership and covenant among our congregations and ministers? Where are the participants? What else do we need to do?

This letter is turning out to be a little negative and that wasn't my intent. My intent was to remind us that we are in this together, that covenant is mutual and that we each have responsibilities in maintaining and growing our relationships with each other. I hope I have done that.

In the meantime, please register for upcoming events. Use scholarships if needed. Get your delegates registered for the Fall Conference meeting. Be in partnership with the many ministry teams and committee who are providing the best they can for each of us. We are in covenant and ministry together. Let us move into our calling, that all may be one. Blessings, Bonnie
