



But over the past 100 years, the amazement of Habakkuk 1:5 is once again appropriate: "Look among the nations! Observe! Be astonished! Wonder! Habakkuk was appalled at the horror of such a judgment and registered his complaint before the Lord. God reiterated the finality of His declaration, saying, "For the vision is yet for the appointed time; it hastens toward the goal and it will not fail. Though it tarries, wait for it; for it will certainly come, it will not delay" (Habakkuk 2:3) In the case of the most important prophetic sign of all, the evidence is right before our eyes. 

The **Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program** opened November 1, 2022. LIHEAP helps families living on low incomes pay their heating bills in the form of a cash grant. Households in immediate danger of being without heat can also qualify for crisis grants. The cash grant is a one-time payment sent directly to the utility company/fuel provider to be credited on your bill. These grants range from \$500 to \$1,500 based on household size, income, and fuel type. Psalm 30:11 "You have turned my mourning into dancing; you have taken off my sackcloth and clothed me with joy."

Dear friends,

We have had sad news about Alan Miller's passing. We have had sad news about others in our midst passing. We are in mourning, and it is good to mourn our losses together and to share our pain with one another. As you have read in the obituary notice that went out, Alan's family will greet visitors on January 5 beginning at 4 pm and his memorial service will be January 6 at 11 am, both at Jordan United Church of Christ, 1837 Church Road, Allentown. I hope some of you will be able to join us as we share our love and support with the family and as we celebrate Alan's life.

We are sad. We lament at the loss and the absence death causes in our lives. Yet, we know that those who have passed from this world, are now in the arms of our loving God, welcomed home into peace and joy. They are clothed with joy.

This doesn't make it any easier to say goodbye. This doesn't make it easier to breathe during the moments of pain and sadness. Yet, we are a resurrection people, a people of hope. During this Advent we have been waiting expectantly for the coming of the Christ Child. We are moving through the progressively shorter days, walking in the darkness, knowing that there is light ahead. That is our faith. That is what moves us and leads us from mourning and lament into joy.

I hope, my beloved, that you take the time to grieve, the time to mourn, the time to lament. I hope you take the breath of the God and inhale it into your being. I hope you will know, in your very bones, that God is walking this journey with you.

One of our lectionary readings for this week is from Isaiah 35. Verses 1-2a read, "The wilderness and the dry land will be glad, the desert will rejoice and blossom; like the crocus it shall blossom abundantly and rejoice with joy and singing. The prophet proclaims a time of renewal, refreshment, and resurrection.

This is what we need as well, especially when our hearts are weary or broken in sorrow and loss. Breathe in God's grace and joy. Believe in God's peace and hope. Know God's love. We do deeply miss Alan Miller and the others in our lives who have died, gone from us, but in the embrace of God. Pray for each other in this time. I am praying for, and with, you.
